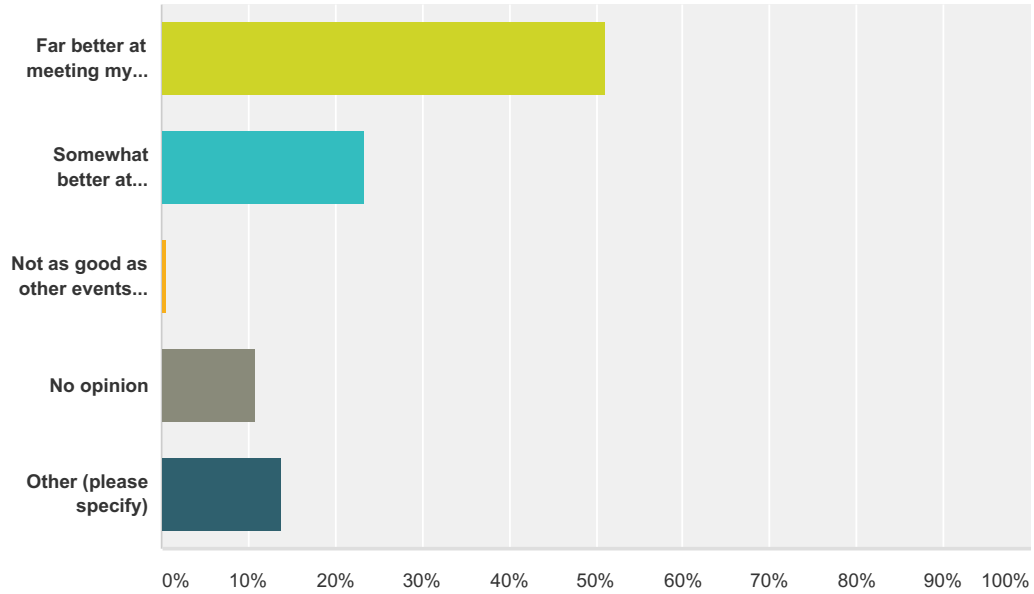

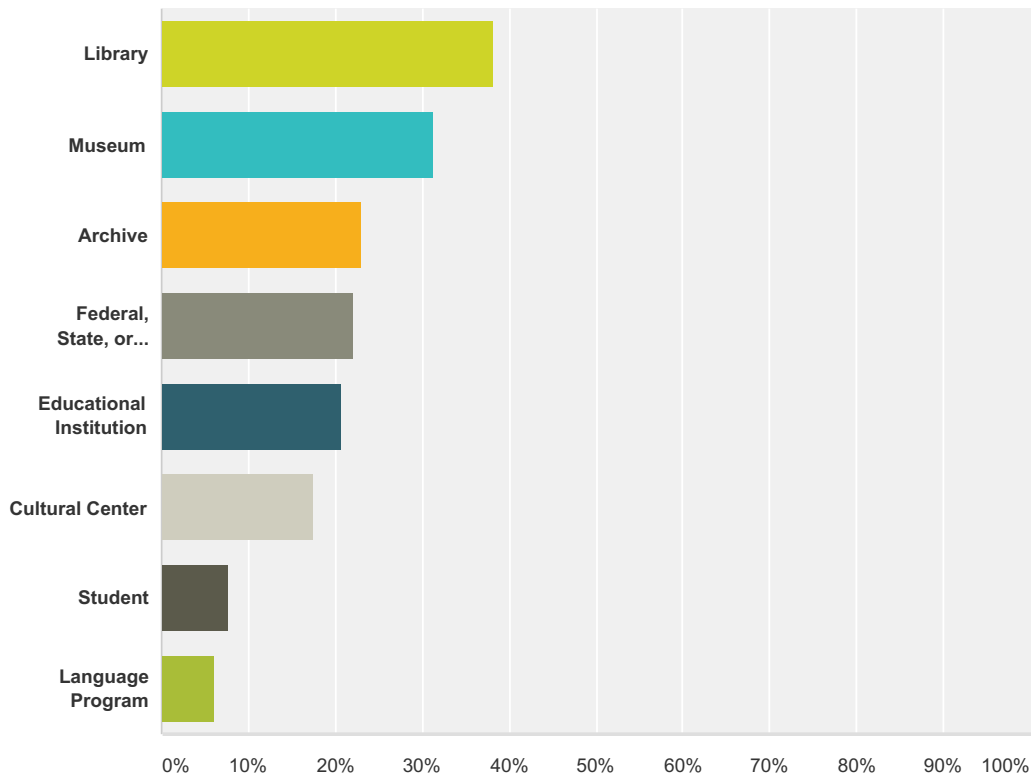

### Q5 What type organization do you represent?

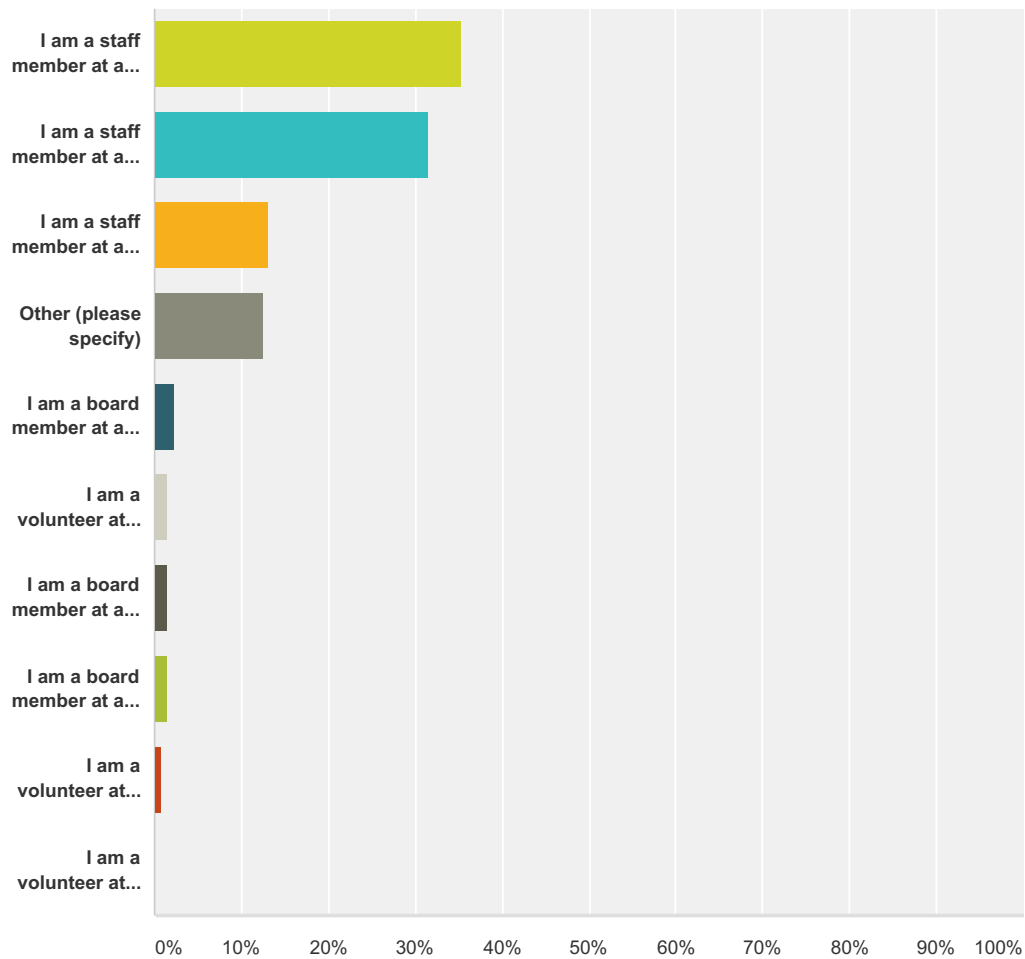

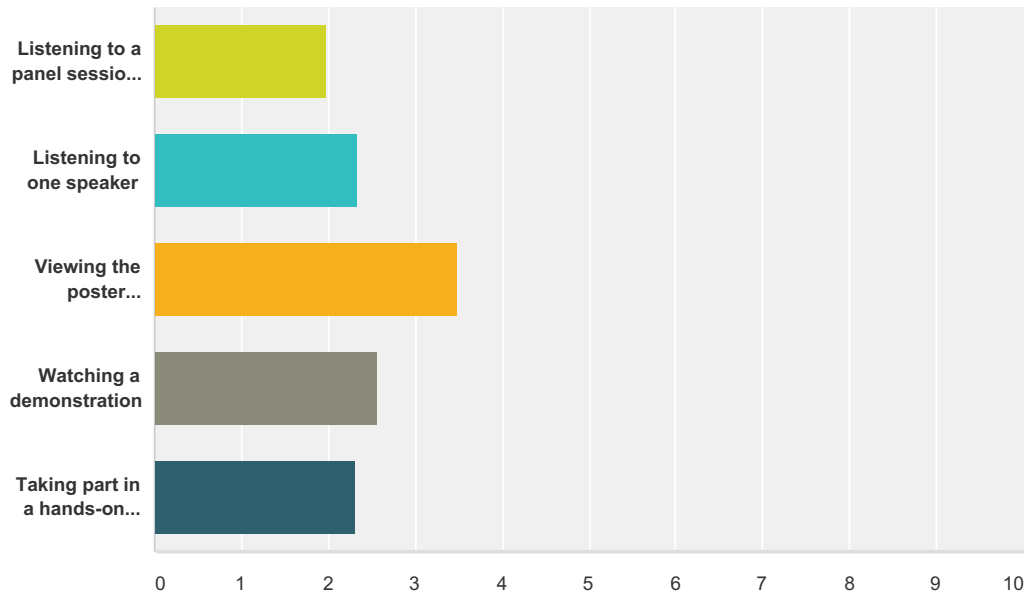

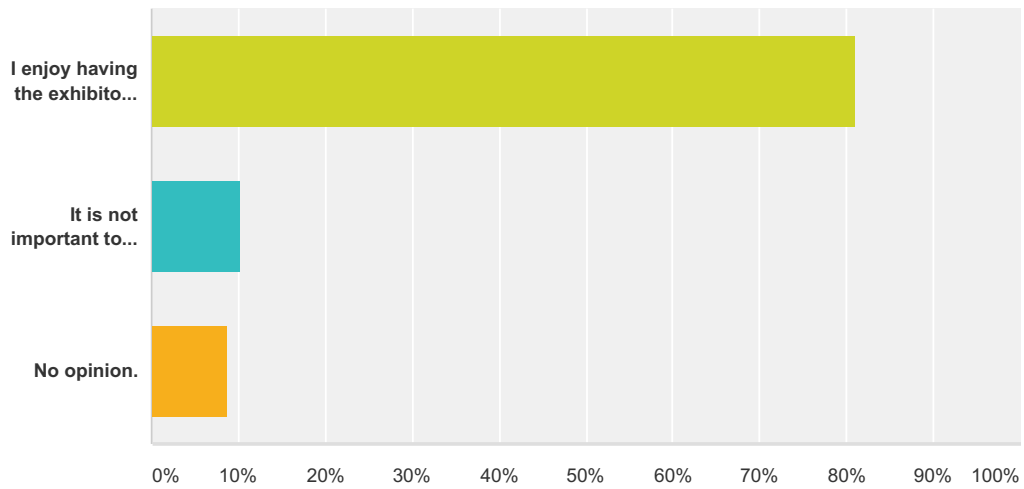

### Q10 How do you feel about having exhibitors at the conference?

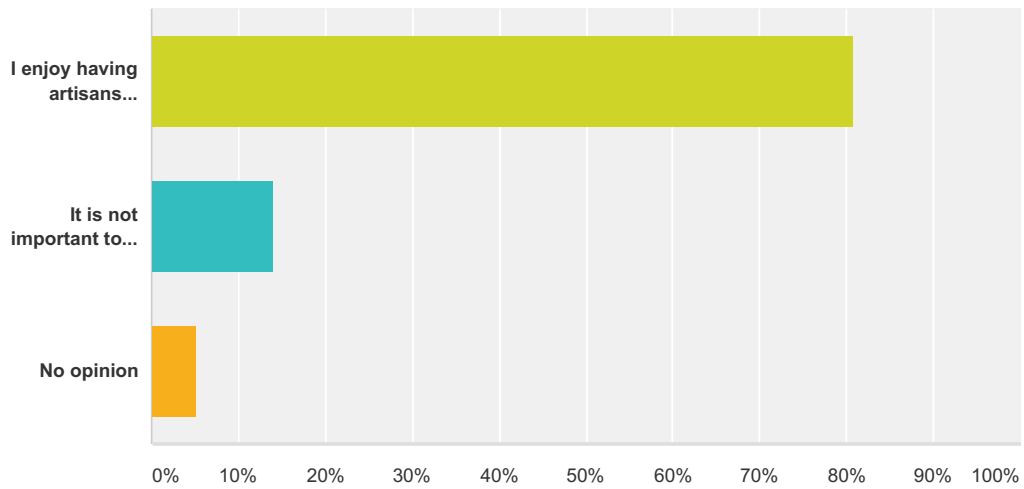

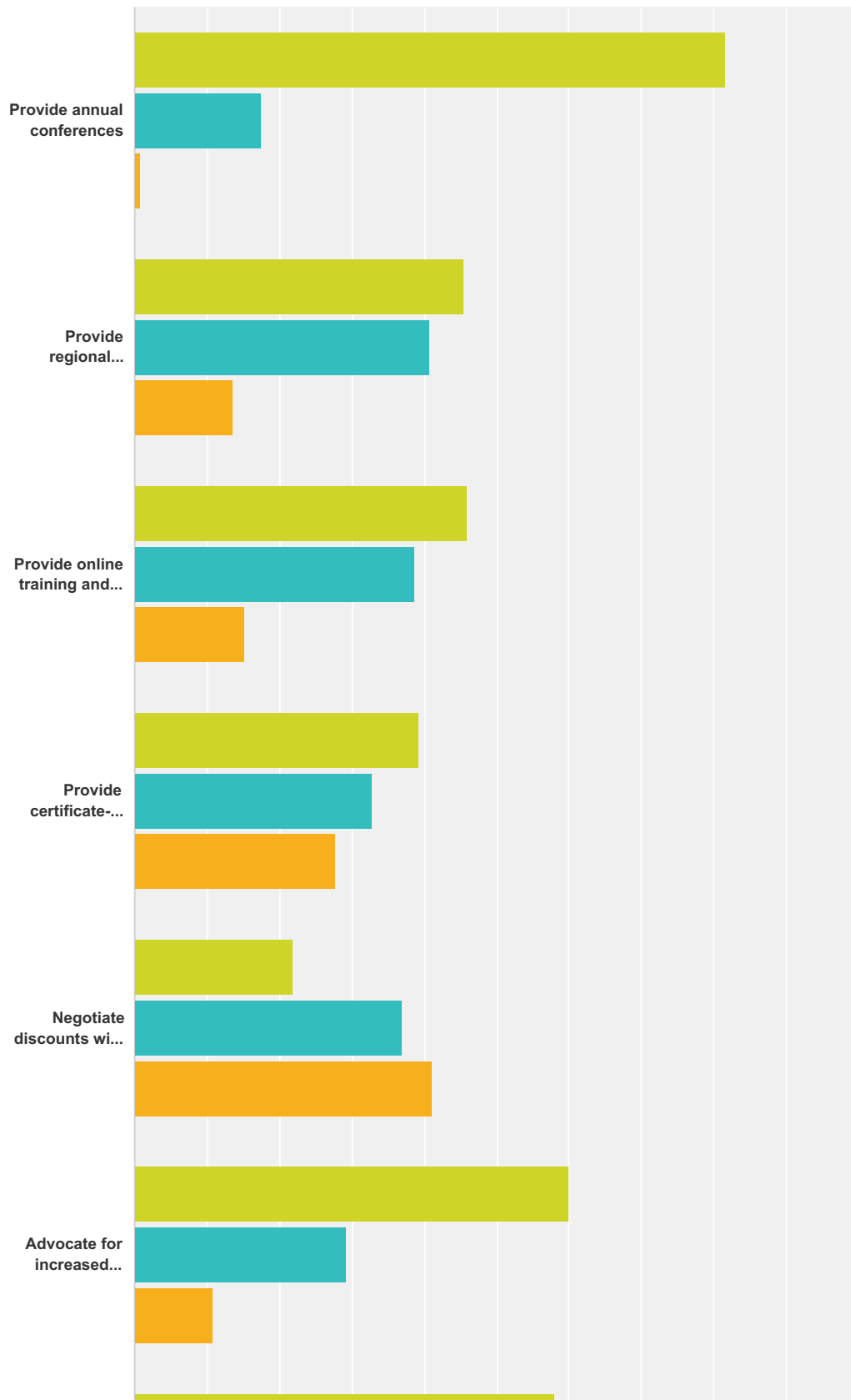

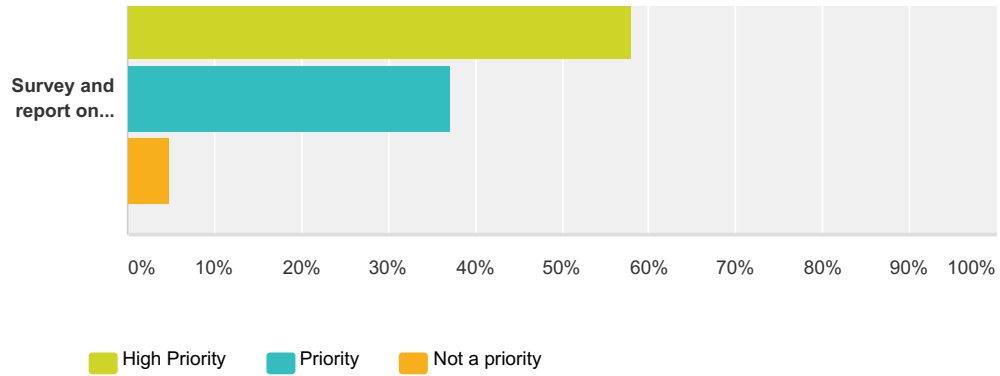
