To earn the Caring for Collections Certificate, you must do the following:

- 1. Submit a brief <u>application</u>. Once your application is approved, you will receive additional information on the pre-conference webinars.
- 2. Participate in at least 20 hours of training, including self-paced webinars in advance of the conference, one full-day workshop on October 9, and seven conference sessions specific to the certificate being earned on October 10-11.
- 3. Work with a cultural institution of your choice to complete a Collections Care Plan, using the training you will receive during the webinars and at conference.
- 4. Complete an evaluation survey and write a brief report.

Certificates will be provided after your special project and report are received.
