- 1. Submit a brief <u>application</u>. Once your application is approved, you will receive additional information on the pre-conference webinars.
- 2. Participate in at least 20 hours of training, including self-paced webinars in advance of the conference, one full-day workshop on October 9, and conference sessions specific to the certificate being earned on October 10 and 11.
- 3. Complete a special project related to digital project management.
- 4. Complete an evaluation survey and write a brief report.

Certificates will be provided after your special project and report are received.
