















Rules, Eligibility and Restrictions

- Organizations receive an allotment of Microsoft software donations that is reset every two years.
- An organization's two-year cycle begins with its first donation request after April 5, 2022. After two years, a new cycle begins, and a new allotment is available.
- Any eligible organization can request up to 50 donated Windows full operating system products during its two-year cycle.
- An eligible organization that operates a computer lab can request up to 50 of each donated desktop product available to computer labs during its two-year cycle.




\$120 (\$10 per month for 12 months, paid annually in advance).

Payments are 2 part processing but if it's a bulk request (55+ or more) pricing can be included in the TechSoup invoice.

The 4G LTE wireless broadband service offered by Mobile Beacon uses the same network as the 4G services offered by many telecommunications companies.

Its download speeds average 6 to 8 megabits per second, with peak speeds of 25.


